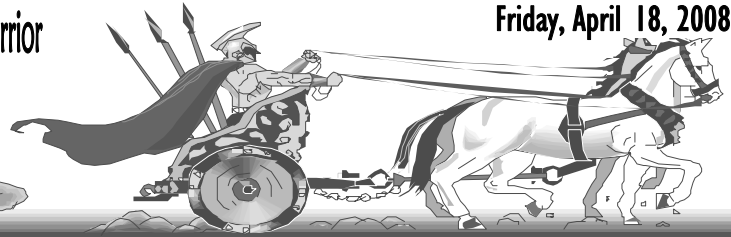

## Is there a Christian approach to teaching history?
